



## Alpine Canada Alpin Equipment Policy and Rental Agreement

*Updated May 2008*

**SECTION A-**Alpine Canada Alpin is please to announce that for the 2008-09 seasons it will have an equipment rental program in place. The rental program will be put in place so that clubs and Race organizing Committees can have access to World Class equipment. This equipment has been accumulated through out the past 10 years from the Lake Louise Winterstart World Cup and is now available for events across the country. In the efforts to help and better the quality of ski racing in Canada Alpine Canada Alpin will have the following equipment for rent.

The Alpine Canada Alpin (ACA) equipment will be provided at no charge to the ROC's for ACA Events (Coupe Pontiac GMC Cup's, NorthWest Mutual Funds Coupe Nor-Am Cup's, J1 Championships, K2 Championship, CFAST race events, and Pontiac GMC Canadian Championships). All events outside of ACA will be charged the below rental fees.

### **SECTION C-Policies and Procedures**

#### **1) Payment**

- Payment can be made by cash, credit card or cheque
- A deposit for 100% of the cost must be provided prior to transportation.
- Payment must be made through Alpine Canada Alpin via the ACA- Equipment Manager

#### **2) Reservation and Cancellation**

- Equipment can be reserved in advance and should be made no later then 15 days before the event.
- Cancellation of requested equipment must be made by contacting the ACA- Equipment manager no later then 5 days before event. Equipment orders cancelled after this deadline will be subject to a cancellation fee of 10% of the rental cost.

#### **3) Pick up and Delivery**

- Transportation of rented equipment must be coordinate through the ACA- Equipment Manager
- All equipment should be returned no later than 5 days after the event (Monday-Friday, 9:00am - 4:00pm). Any other arrangements must be approved by ACA- Equipment Manger

**4) Damaged and lost equipment**

- On arrival the equipment rented will be inspected for damage or determined to be lost. Damage, such as the following, will be added to the rental cost
  - Cut snow fencing
  - Damage to radios
  - Cut B-netting
  - Broken shovels or rakes
  - Broken polycarbonate poles
- The renter will be responsible for any lost or destroyed equipment
- The cost of the lost or destroyed equipment will be charged at the current market rates.

**SECTION D-Transportation and Inventory**

In the event that the assigned equipment is coordinated to be transported to another location and not back to ACA, the equipment must be accounted for and signed off by the appropriate person. The following form must be filled out and signed, thus making the renter accountable for loss, stolen or damaged equipment.
